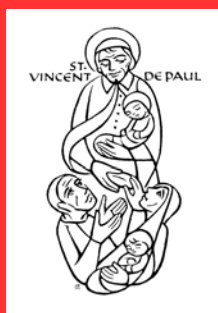


St. Vincent's Week
